High performance organisation centre holds seminar

The local business communities get state-of-the-art research knowledge, including a new book, with which they can transform their organisations into HPO," he said.

Mr Mulimbika also said

that the seminar will benefit the statutory bodies under the MCTI by working efficiently and to benchmark their performance.

"In an effort to improve the performance and efficiency of the ministry and its statutory bodies, we strongly believe that the findings and approaches recommended by this study would go a long way if adopted, adapted and assimilated in the strategic structures and processes of our units.

Meanwhile associate professor strategic management at the Maastricht School of Management André de Waal said the adoption of the HPO framework has been validated in many case studies around the world.

Dr Waal, who is also the author of a book titled 'What

Makes An HPO: Five Validated Factors That Apply Worldwide (published in September 2012 by Global Professional Publishing), said that the book also provides important information on HPOs.

He said the academic and practical research and the case studies of organisations all over the world described in the book show that organisations using the HPO framework are performing better than ever before
